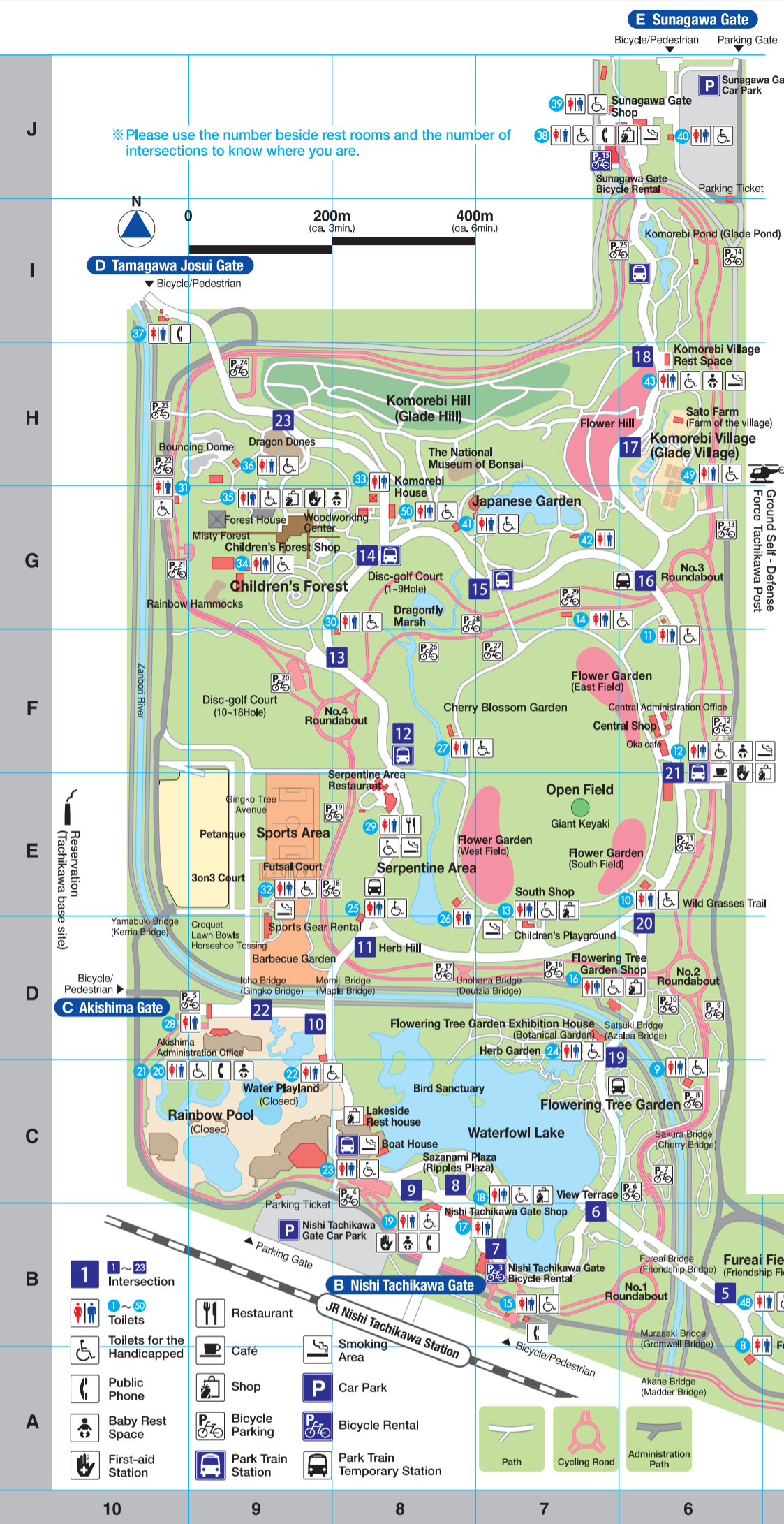

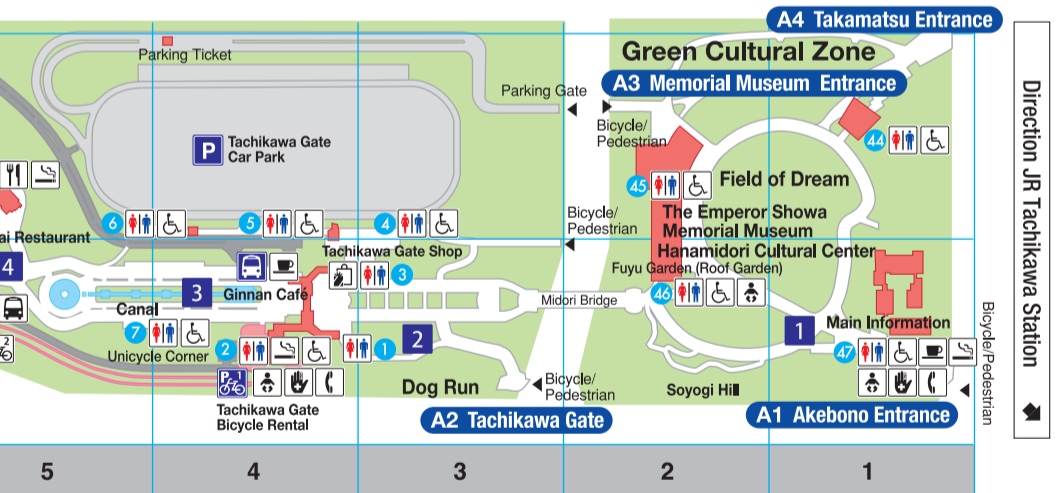

<b>November 1 to the end of February</b>	<b>9:30 A.M. to 4:30 P.M.</b>

\* Green Cultural Zone (Free Area) opens at 8:30 A.M.  
 \* Green Cultural Zone (Free Area) closes at 5:30 P.M. from Spring Equinox Day to March 31.  
 \* Park opening hours may change depending on events or other occasions.  
 \* The Emperor Showa Memorial Museum is closed any day the park is closed, Mondays (closed next normal weekday if Monday is a holiday), Fridays (open if Friday is a holiday), and during preparation periods for special exhibits, planned exhibits, and other exhibits.

Closed Tuesdays in June to August and December to February. Closed December 30 - January 1 and the fourth week of January.

\*All areas excluding the Green Cultural Zone (the Hanamidori Cultural Center and the General Information Booth) require an admission ticket to be purchased.  
 \*Park facilities are available for use starting at 9:30 A.M. (excluding restaurants, Oka cafe, and the woodworking center). \* = subject to fees

- ### Precautions for Using the Park
- Observe the following rules when using the park.**
- Do not bend the plants or attempt to catch the wildlife.
  - Bonfires and fireworks are prohibited.
  - Area enclosed with a sign saying "No Entry" are dangerous area or the plants are being protected. Therefore, do not enter those areas.
  - In cycling course you can use only bicycle. (Walking is prohibited.)
  - Cooperate in reducing garbage by taking your home with you. If discarding wastes, separate them into the proper types and place them in the proper garbage bins.
  - Smoking is allowed only in places where there are ashtrays available.
  - Adults bringing along small children must never lose sight of them in the park.
  - People bringing along pets to the park must always keep the animal on a leash. The owner of the animal must take responsibility for cleaning up any excrement of the animal. The park does not bear any responsibility for actions relating to pets in the park. The owner of the pet is responsible. Pet are not allowed in the Japanese Garden, buildings such as restaurants, Park Train, Boats. (Guide dogs are allowed.)
  - Visitors to the park should avoid causing trouble to its management.
  - Metal or wooden bats, boomerangs, model airplanes, skateboards, sleds, bug nets, fishing poles, large tents, and golf clubs or other objects that would hinder the management of the park are prohibited from use. Additional equipment is limited. Contact each gate or the Showa Management Center for details. Please check our website for more information.
